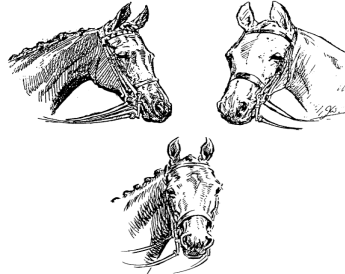

2. This show is run in accordance with the 2010 Rules of the British Show Horse Association
3. No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for any loss, damage, illness or injury sustained by the exhibitors, riders or their horses or any other person connected. Entries are accepted on this basis.
4. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel any class if there are insufficient entries, or to amend conditions of any class at their discretion.
5. While every effort will be made to avoid classes clashing, the Show cannot be held responsible if due to large entries classes overrun.
6. Novice classes are open to registered Hacks, Cobs and Riding Horses which have not won a first prize of £25 or more or a total of £100 in any showing classes affiliated to the BSHA, at home or abroad, prior to 1st January 2010. Winnings gained as a 4yr old are excepted unless the animal has won an open class. A novice may be shown in a snaffle bridle.
7. Amateur Owner/Rider and Amateur Owner/Rider Home Produced classes are open to registered Hacks, Cobs and Riding Horses as defined in the 2010 BSHA Rule Book.
8. Class 17 and 18 are qualifiers for the BSPA Championships to be held at the RIHS please see information box at end of schedule.
9. Non members may compete in BSHA Classes 8 to 10, 13 to 15, and 18 to 22 providing that they have purchased a 'Day Ticket' for further details please contact the office Tel: 01462 437770

The Blue Chip & Irish Draught (GB) £2,000 Challenge

The Qualifying horses from classes 1,2,3,8, 15 & 18 will be the highest placed horse (not already qualified) that is registered or eligible for registration on the Irish Draught or Irish Draught Sports Horse Register, i.e. with a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding. The horse need not be registered to qualify but MUST be on the IDHS (GB) registers by the time of the Championship Final which will be held at the IDHS (GB) Annual Breed Show in September, see IDS (GB) web site.

NB A horse may only qualify once regardless of how many times classes are won, placed in or entered. Each qualifier will receive a rosette and a £10 voucher from Blue Chip. In the final, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money plus a Blue Chip Rug, the Reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition the highest placed Pure Bred will receive a Trophy and £100 and the highest placed 158 cm and under will receive a Trophy and £50.

RING 1 - 9.00 am

Class 1 RIHS LIGHTWEIGHT COB - mare or gelding, 4 years old or over exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms, capable of carrying up to 14 stone.

Class 11 CLASSICAL LADIES SIDE-SADDLE CLASS - Qualifier for National Side-saddle

Championships. Open to SSA members and non-members, aged 16 or over on 1st Jan in current year, riding side saddle, on horses exceeding 148cms. To be judged 25% manners and way of going, 25% action and conformation, 25% Rider, 25% turn out of horse and rider. Traditional Habits must be worn. Fancy dress and Period costumes are not permitted. NB Silk hats are permitted to be worn in this class AT ANY TIME OF DAY. A special rosette to the highest placed SSA carrying their current Championship Points Card. The highest placed Horse/Rider combination qualifies for the Finals to be held at the National Side Saddle Championships. In the event of previous qualification then this may be passed down to the 4th place. Qualifying combinations must become Full Members of the SSA 21 days prior to the National Side Saddle Show to be eligible to compete at the final.

Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, any height. Riders must be 15 years or over. Horses should be ridden in a Snaffle, Pelham or simple Double Bridle. Horses should be plaited. The first two go forward to the championship at the Hickstead Derby meeting on 27th June 2010. Qualification will go down to 4th place if the first two have already qualified. All entries **MUST** be registered with Weatherbys in their General Stud Book and **MUST** also be registered with the ROR. The class is open to thoroughbreds that have RACED. ALL HORSES/PONIES MUST BE REGISTERED AND ALL OWNERS AND RIDERS BSPA MEMBERS PRIOR TO THE SHOW. Riders age taken from the 1st January. All stallions must be graded and licensed with BSPA. No rider under the age of 14 may exhibit a stallion in any class. **Membership and qualification cards must be carried in the ring by riders and produced as required for inspection or signature.** **Failure to do so will mean disqualification.** Spurs may not be worn in any pony class. All ponies 153cm and under (with the exception of shetlands and miniatures who are exempt) must possess a current JMB Height Certificate submitted to BSPA prior to the Show.
